- ✓ Local economy will suffer by the transition to clean energy production.






#### Race and Port Locations

Two potential locations for Externe-E event:


- 1. "Ptolemaida" with nearest ports "Thessaloniki" and "Igoumenitsa".

Argos Orestiko Location may be interacted with the concept of "bringing renewable and clean energy close to people" so to make population familiar with new technologies.


Ptolemaida Location may be interacted with the concept of "energy transition" from the dirt old lignite used for electricity plants to new renewable and clean energy.

Argos Orestiko is the second option for Extreme E.


It provides excellent infrastructures

Bivouac to be settled in a spacious area inside the city


Proximity to high standard accommodation facilities
